Materials	A recording of the news / voice recorder	Daily study time	
Methods	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pause the tape after listening to each sentence. 2. After you have paused the tape, try to repeat the section you just listened to. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Expressions may differ from the original content, but if the meaning of the content is expressed correctly (If the meaning is the same) then that is fine. 3. Record your own English after listening to the tape one more time. Compare your English to the original to improve your accuracy. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Do not take any notes. All practice should be done verbally. * The more you practice, the more you will be able to reproduce smooth English. Use this study method as much as possible. If you continue for more than 3 months, it will become easier to remember English you hear. 		
Summarize ...			
Materials	Notebook, Voice recorder	Daily study time	
Methods	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Listen to the recording one more time. 2. Stop the CD and organize the content of the recording in your mind. (Japanese is okay!) Try to do this in one minute or less. 3. Summarize the recording verbally and record it on tape. 4. Listen to your recording and compare it with the original. Take note of any vocabulary and expressions that you think should have been included in your summary. Try to summarize the news recording one more time and include these vocabulary and expressions. 5. Present the final version of your summary to your teacher at your next lesson and get some feedback. Avoid using any notes when presenting.
